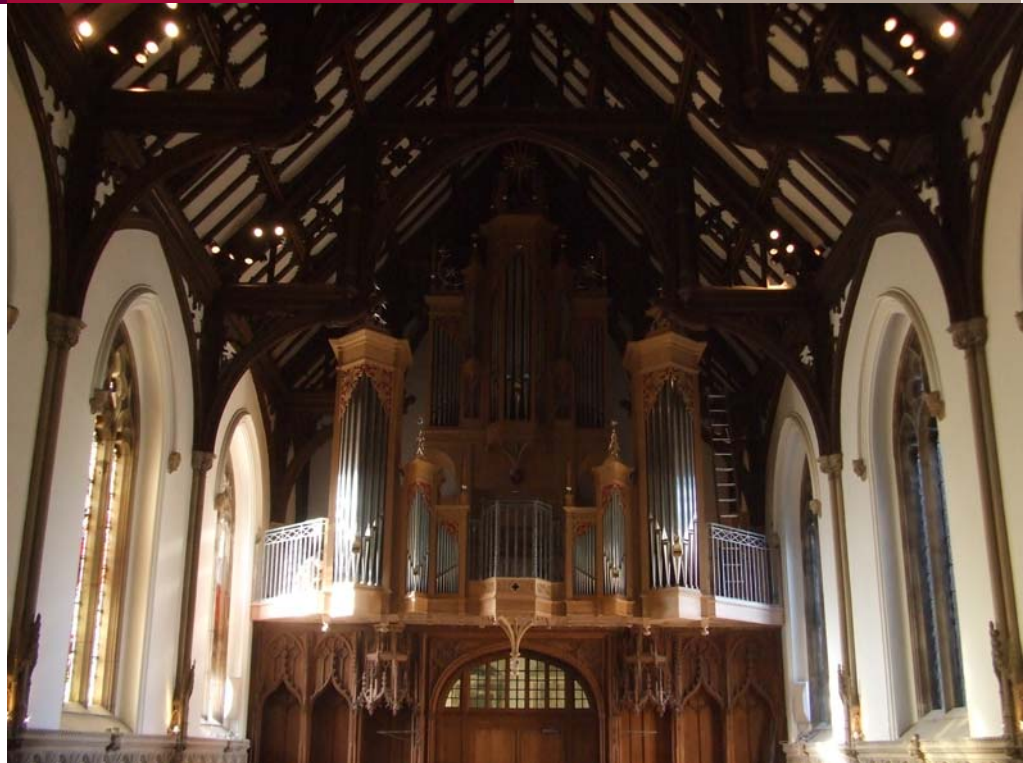

Description

After the Oxford College commissioned a new Organ, a new structure within the chapel was required to support it.

The works involved:

- Removal of the sedilian and existing organ gallery.
- Design and procurement of new structural steel and framework.
- New oak spiral staircase and doors to gain access to the organ itself.
- Rendering inter-quadrangle corridor to simulate ashlar.
- Re-installment of the sedilian.
