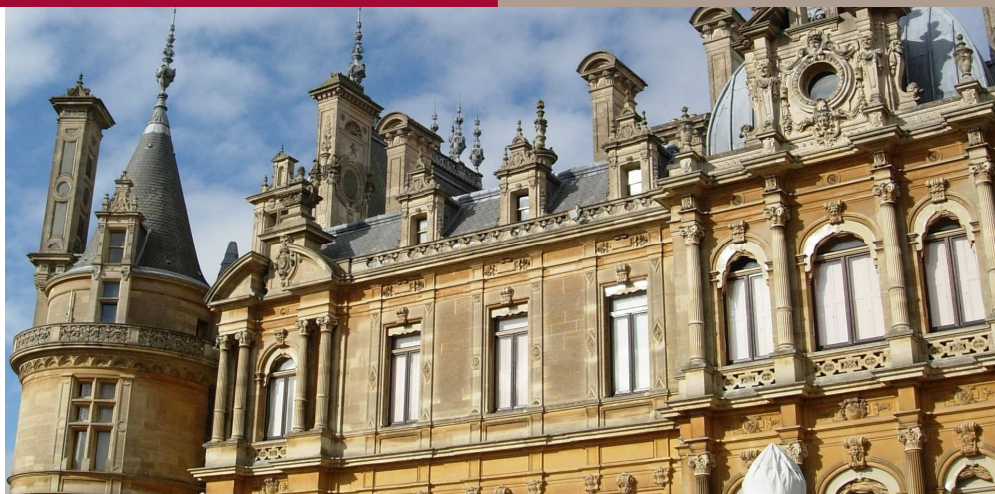

Description
